Ironically he was returning from a fundraising fishing tournament to help a young man who had been in car accident. Devin spent months in a coma, but has since entered into a semi-conscious state and continues to show signs of improvement each day. Prior to the accident, Devin was in his third year of law school at Stetson University. Devin is a graduate of the University of Notre Dame, class of 2006, and a graduate of the Benjamin School, class of 2002.

For those who know Devin, he needs no introduction. Devin Kirvin brightens the world with his captivating personality and sense of humor. He is passionate about his family, friends, the United States of America, and Notre Dame football. Devin never misses an opportunity to make people laugh, and his passion for life is obvious to everyone around him. In high school, students gave Devin the nickname "Hurricane" for the intensity that he brought on the football field. Devin brings that same intensity to his personal life, especially to his relationship with friends and family.

Several of us have started a group called the "Friends of Devin." Our group was formed to provide support to the Kirvin family and to keep his friends informed of his progress.
